How to Apply: The application and guidelines are available in January on the agency's website. First-time applicants should contact agency staff via phone or email to discuss their eligibility and the appropriateness of their project.

Restrictions: Individual artists must be full-time Colorado residents for at least three years and their proposed projects must show community involvement and benefit. Organizations must be in existence in Colorado for at least three years. Organizations that receive Scientific Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) funding are only eligible for in-school projects that take place outside the SCFD area, or for professional development activities that take place outside the SCFD area.
