Excluded counties include: Adams; Arapahoe; Boulder; Broomfield; Clear Creek; Denver; Douglas; Elbert; El Paso; Gilpin; Jefferson; Larimer; Mesa; Park; Pueblo; Teller; and Weld, unless an organization in one of the above counties is located more than 30 miles from the nearest hospital of more than 25 beds.
