**How to Apply:** Prospective applicants are encouraged to call to discuss their proposal before applying. The Foundation prefers to receive electronic grant applications through the website, where complete instructions for online submissions can be found.

**Restrictions:** The Foundation will generally not make grants for/to: individuals; programs that require membership in a certain religion or advance a particular religious faith; for-profit organizations or programs operated by or for the benefit of for-profit organizations; debt retirement; annual fund drives; fund-raising events; endowments. A proposal will not be accepted if: it is received after 5 pm on the deadline date; it is incomplete; the applicant organization discriminates on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, citizenship status, age, disability, sexual orientation or veteran status.
