How to Apply: The Foundation has one stream of funding open to the nonprofit community, the Direct Service Fund. The Fund issues grants (\$5,000) to nonprofit organizations throughout the state that work with women and girls and economic self-sufficiency. The Foundation accepts the CGA with modifications. Please check the website in January of each year to obtain a copy of the Direct Service Guidelines and deadlines, and to learn more about the Foundation's funding areas. Through the Public Policy Fund and other Donor Advised Funds, the Foundation will solicit specific organizations with which to partner. These funding streams are invitation only. Research and education events are facilitated through the Women's Foundation's staff.
